


## Quirónsalud Málaga Hospital



More than 850 employees, including 200 physicians and surgeons from different specialties to provide high quality comprehensive care. We emphasize attention to international patients, growing year after year, due to our provision of additional services, especially designed for every need, personalizing all of our services. Quirónsalud Málaga Hospital is the establishment within the Quirónsalud Group with the greatest registered growth, both in terms of activity and turnover, in Andalusia in the last few years. Our hospital currently registers 30,000 hospitalisations; 13,600 surgical procedures; 1,200 births; 272,000 medical consultations; 104,000 emergencies and 85,000 radiology studies. Moreover, Hospital Quirónsalud Malaga specialises in reconstruction surgery and has a Comprehensive Breast Unit.






## Quirónsalud Málaga Médical Centre

How to get here

Quirónsalud Málaga Hospital is situated at Avenida Imperio Argentina no. 1, Urbanización Parque Litoral, in the West of Malaga. This is a strategic area with excellent transport connections to the city centre, the various urban centres on the Costa and the main capital cities in Andalusia, offering direct connections to the main urban centres of the province and the city centre:



## Transport Connections

- **N-340:** Airport at 4.2 km and industrial estates of the metropolitan area.
- A-7: Congress Hall at 3.5 km and main urban centres on the Costa del Sol.
- Malaga Motorway: Seville, Granada and Cadiz.
- **Coast Motorway:** City centre at 4.5 km.
- Malaga Airport at 4.2 km.
- María Zambrano Train Station at 3.8 km

- Underground: Line 2, stop at Palacio de Deportes (Sports Palace). Line 2 of the Malaga Underground System makes it possible for anyone to travel from the western area of the city to the various areas of the city centre. It has stops at Palacio de Deportes, Puerta Blanca, La Luz- La Paz, El Torcal, Princesa Huelin, La Isla with the last stop being El Perchel.
- **Taxi:** There is a taxi rank just outside the outpatient care consultation building.
- Gibraltar Airport at 125 km.





How to get here

## By road

Like the rail network, the Costa del Sol road network connects with other cities throughout Andalusia and Spain as a whole, via motorways and toll roads. Attention should be drawn to the A-7 and A-45, excellent infrastructures for vehicular transit. Getting here by bus also proves very easy, as Málaga Bus Station provides connections to practically all areas of Spain and all the towns and villages within the province.

## By train

The Costa del Sol rail network provides connections to other cities in Andalusia and the rest of Spain. Travelling from Málaga, the hub is the Málaga-María Zambrano Train Station (ADIF), which provides high-speed connections between the Costa del Sol and Madrid in two and a half hours, along with links to Barcelona, Seville and Valencia, amongst other cities.


## By plane

The Málaga-Costa del Sol Airport numbers amongst the airports with the highest volume of passenger flow in Spain. Cities such as London, Paris, Berlin, Rome, New York and Moscow have direct connections with Málaga Airport, which is also the main airport of and point of entry into Andalusia.

## By sea

The Port of Málaga, Spain's second most important in terms of cruise ships, caters to the biggest shipping companies in the world and provides sea access to those docking or stopping over in Málaga. The Costa del Sol's capital is a destination for luxury cruises with Mediterranean routes and even berthed what was once the biggest ship in the world in 2015, the Allure of the Seas.

The Port of Málaga also provides direct connections with North Africa, with daily ferries to Melilla.



About Málaga

About Málaga

Málaga is the capital of the Costa del Sol. Ranks fifth in number of inhabitants in Spain. The Municipal Area is 398.25 square kilometres and the population is approximately 568,000 inhabitants, although the metropolitan area has nearly a million inhabitants.

The climatic and geographic factors which have mostly impacted the development and evolution of the city are the influence of the sea, the location of the Municipality situated on two river valleys (Guadalhorce and Guadalmedina), its terrain and climate.


Mediterranean Sea and the Mountains of Málaga, make possible Málaga and its province, to enjoy a mild weather all year round. July and August are the warmest months, and December and January, the coldest. However, temperatures average in Winter vary between 22,8°C and a minimum of 13°C.

Malaga holds natural heritage of great environmental beauty. The natural site of the mouth of River Guadalhorce, situated within a 122-hectare island bordered by the final sections of the river branches, is an area of transit for hundreds of migration species of high ecological value. The Montes de Malaga Natural Park covers an area of 4,996 hectares, providing shelter to over 230 plat species and over 160 vertebrates.







