During his career he has been combining his medical practice with a teaching role and he is the mentor of Resident Doctors and Head of Studies at the Carlos Haya Hospital in Malaga. Additionally, Dr Contreras Martínez has been the President of the Spanish Society of Radiation Oncology for 4 years (he is currently Advisory President) and the Andalusian Cancerology Society (SAC, in its Spanish abbreviation).

At the same time, he is an active member in national and international patient associations.
